

**Dan Reiter** (cello) is principal cellist with the Oakland East Bay Symphony (OEBS), Festival Opera Orchestra, Diablo Ballet Orchestra and Fremont Symphony. His solo work has included Leonard Bernstein's *Three Meditations* (OEBS, 2000) and Robert Schumann's *Cello Concerto* (Fremont Symphony, 2002). Dan is also a former Earplay member (1989-90).

As a composer, Dan has written varied chamber works. In 1999 he won an Izzy Award for his composition *Raga Bach B Minor* featuring dancer Robert Moses. He has had the privilege of working with India's master musician Ali Akbar Khan and has recorded two CDs (*Garden of Dreams* and *Legacy*) with Khansahib. In addition, Dan produced *Cello and Harp*, a CD of his compositions for cello and harp with his wife, Natalie Cox.
